This RN position is located in the Medicine Unit.

Starting Base pay for an RN 1 is \$19.50 hourly and for RN 2 it is \$20.87. Shift Differential pay is as follows, shift 2 - \$3.00, shift 3 - \$4.60, weekend - \$4.60 and holiday - \$4.60. Certification pay is \$1.50 each with a maximum of two. The shifts are 12 hours, rotating weekends and holidays. Domicile premium pay is \$3.00. Benefits include optional health Insurance, retirement, optional miscellaneous insurances, a generous annual and sick leave policy and 14 paid Holidays.
