DESCRIPTION:

Lallie Kemp Medical Center is a Critical Access Hospital in Independence, LA.

This is an administrative level position that directs the activities of the Ancillary Services Division at LSU HCSD Lallie Kemp Regional Medical Center (LKMC). The Ancillary Services Division includes Radiology, Inpatient Rehabilitation, Pathology, Pharmacy, Medication Procurement, Cardiopulmonary Services and Dietary.

Directs and supervises the organizational delivery of quality and timely services and functions of comprehensive and specialized functions of ancillary patient service departments. Two (2) year of this experience must have been in overseeing (supervision/managing) a health services or support program in a hospital or health care facility; or directing a multi-facility health services or support program at the corporate level with jurisdiction over the development and implementation of that program.
